

Robert “Bob” Bell Honored For His Dedicated Service to AF of M Local 336



On April 22, 2012, Local 336 Burlington, New Jersey, held a general membership meeting at the Cafe' Gallery in Burlington, New Jersey, .

This meeting was a brunch meeting free to all paid up members of Local 336. Those in attendance witnessed a celebration of Robert J Bell's 50 years of service to Local 336 and to the federation as a champion of small locals and of live music.
